The Annual Day is the day when we take stock of the year gone by, review the achievements & the innovations.

Phrasing the journey of Shiva International School from the day of its inception in the year 2015, it was indeed the modest & humble beginning to fully fledge senior secondary C.B.S.E. affiliated school today.

Presently Shiva Group is serving to fulfill the dreams of 2000 + students. We groomed from 176 students in its first year to approximately 850 in the present 5<sup>th</sup> year so I thank parents for showing faith in us. **Shiva International School** has been set up for a noble cause to spread knowledge and enlighten the students. To achieve all the things one needs a dedicated faculty and we are happy to escalate the team from 25 in the first year to 80 staff members including teaching and non teaching. We have highly talented, qualified, well experienced and trained 37 teachers who work hard day and night to take best out of our students. They adopt uniform system of assessment which is divided into two evaluations for junior classes in September and March. 4 FA's, 2 SAs in class 1 and 2 and 2 PTs and 2 SAs for class 3 onwards. Our teachers constantly strive to stay updated by attending workshop and various training programs conducted in school campus or outside. There were workshops on smart class teaching, effective communication, personality development and life skill for teachers. These were conducted by our professional guests during the academic session. This year also different workshops were conducted by CBSE in our school campus like Gender Sensitivity, Modern Skills for Educationists, Remodeled Assessment and on Life Skills.

The school is making the tremendous progress in all the aspects of education. Shiva International School in the real sense of the word focuses on the holistic development of every student but at the same time we ensure that the academic training takes the centre stage in our system and our results do showcase this fact.

The Board result of our first X class which appeared during Session 2018-19 were marvelous. All 24 students got marks above 74%.

Out of 24, 15 students got the distinctions.

Our one student **Atisha** got 2<sup>nd</sup> Rank with 96.4% in district Bilaspur.

**Asmanya** got 3<sup>rd</sup> Rank with 96% in district.

**Vinay** got 3<sup>rd</sup> position with 94% in school

Academic being a top priority to us we ensure that our students are provided with best facilities to equip them for a successful life in the years ahead. Consequently we are offering mentorship as well as extra classes to students. Concept of worksheet has also been introduced so that slow learner students can also cope up with the new patterns. Concept of remedial classes in school is also provided for the slow learners in all subjects as well as for higher classes.

We also conduct various Olympiad exams time to time for our students. This year we have introduced Global Olympiad along with science Olympiad Foundation. Olympiads are to prepare the students for various competitive exams which they are going to face in their future. These Olympiads not only make the students aware of the competitive world but also build confidence in them. The result of this year SISIANs Clinched various prizes like **Arunima** Student of Class 7S got cash prize of Rs. 1000 for OGO Scholarship. **Kartik** of Class 7S got selected in semi final for National Level Indianna Quiz league and got 53 rank. Some of the students achieve Gold Medal in International English Olympiad (IEO) and the name of students are **Rishita Thakur** of class 3, **Sujain Chauhan** class 4, **Avneesh Chandel** and **Parnika Sharma** class 5, **Aditi Sharma** Class 6, **Tamanna** class 7, **Namita Thakur** class 8.

A state level abacus test was also conducted in school in which 61 students from class 2 to 5 participated in which **Kavya** and **Bhuvnesh** of class 2, **Yogesh** Kumar Class 3, **Vansh Bhardwaj** class 4, **Ayush Sama** class 5 clinched gold medals.

The major achievement of this year include selection of students for State Level CSC

**Hardik Parmar** class9, **Harshit Nadda** class 8 were selected as the most active students at District level and participated in state level.

In Scientific Project Report **Ansh Misra, Sarthak, Akshay Aanad, Krish Monga** of class9 grabbed position at district level and participated in state level.

In Scientific Model the concept of Smart Helmet was prepared by **Shivangi Ratwan** of class +1 and you all must know that her Model was the hot topic in National channels and newspapers during her presentation at state level.

So keeping this in mind an **educational excursion** was planned for science city Jalandhar and Anandpur Sahib (Viraste Khalsa) so that students can have firsthand experience of various scientific processes and knowledge about glorious history. This year we have introduced new activities like Pottery, Diya painting, zorbe ball, Burma Bridge and Micky mouse for primary wing in our summer camp which was organized in month of June – July.

Every Saturday is a bagless day for the students and activity based time table is implemented. Students participate actively in smart class for science and social studies, creative writing in English and hindi,

science project, mental math's, Cookery Class, karate class, Instrumental music and dance. A concept of **STEM** Science Kit has been introduced to develop their scientific skills.

This year we have conducted around **20** Competitions throughout the year and around **804** prizes will be distributed in this annual function which includes around (**61**) prizes of getting full marks in their abacus tests. Some of the prizes are not included in this list which we have already distributed at Grand Parents Day Celebration as well as on the Sports Day. So in total the number of momentous for achievements to be distributed reaches somewhere around (**1147**) in one academic session which has only 220 working days. Yesterday we have distributed 460 prizes and today we are distributing around 520 prizes.

Sports Day was organized in the school on 14<sup>th</sup> November. Students participated in various games and won many prizes. In sports section this year As we all know sports and physical activities are integral part of students' life. Students of Shiva International School participated in various sports activities. **Parnika Sharma** class 5 in Badminton, **Shivam Chandel & Muskaan** of class 5 in Kabaddi, **Tanya** class 3 in Kho-kho selected at District Level Tournament. **Arushi** class 7 selected for National Level Karate Tournament which will be held in State Manipur. **Pranav** of class 5, **Rigved** of class 8, **Kundan, Tarsem & Aryan** of class 9 won Gold Metal at State Level and selected for National Level Kick Boxing Tournament.

The incident of Delhi school has shook us so we have installed **cctv** cameras in School, and transportation enhanced with GPS and Cameras in buses.

The school is grateful to our chairman and MD sir for providing us enviable campus infrastructure and by employing competent manpower.

It is said that life is a celebration of awakening of new beginnings and wonderful surprises that enlighten human soul. The school celebrates Janmashtami, raksha Bandhan, Ram Navmi, Guru Nanak Jayanti, Christmas, Independence Day, republic day, The Earth Day, World Book Day, Water Day, AIDS Day with great fervor as well as special assemblies are arranged to mark these days.

While keeping our selves abreast with the modern technologies, we try to inculcate moral values in our kids and it was shown by them when they did Guru Puja on Teachers Day and Grand Parents Puja on Grand Parents Day. Our students have given message to the society by making smokeless and noiseless Deepawali.

All students and teachers have been divided into four houses as TULIP, PANSY, DAFFODILS and HIBISCUS and throughout the year there were healthy inter house competitions on various themes to name a few Mahila Shashaktikaran program was the latest organized by each houses through charts, speeches, PPT's, skits, workshops and special Karate classes were organized for girls.

Under the Campaign “Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat” Himachal Pradesh has been Paired with state Kerala so we enabled our students to learn Malyalam language, traditional dance forms of Kerala like **Mohiniattam, kathakkali** and to celebrate the unity in diversity of India you can see that we have chosen Kerala theme for our Annual Day.

Another feather in our cap has been added this year as we got self finance **NSS** unit in our school on 14<sup>th</sup> August 2019. The main objective of the NSS is to render services to the community while studying in an educational institution So moving forward in this line Our Chairman and MD sir have distributed 500 plants to the students on Environment Day to make our contribution to the society for clean and healthy environment and sustainable development.

The students of class 9 worked for land slide hit people of Karyalag with the permission of S.D.M. Ghumarwin. These students along with NSS unit of school started a plantation drive on landslide hit area. We raised the problem of victims regarding livelihood in front of DC Bilaspur and he directed principal of ITI Bilaspur for the same, with the collaboration of ITI Bilaspur Shiva International School organized an employment oriented workshop, one of our achievements in this include some of the victim girls are pursuing the skill development training and one of them is going to get job in February in the nearby native region. we also in collaboration with ITI as well as near by Hosieries arranged training for the ladies of that village so that they can learn their livelihood.

The girls of NSS have sensitized the women of village Barota about maternal health, precautions dos and don'ts during this period and about how to maintain hygiene and nurture themselves during this important phase of their life.

We at Shiva International School emphasizes on clean and green environment by organizing classroom cleanup days, promoting the reuse of newspaper, waste paper and charts and organized the competition like " Best out of Waste" , giving frequent reminders to switch off the lights, fans, water taps etc. when these are not being in use. The ambience created today on the stage by the cutouts and all the flowers used has been made by the waste charts as we always strive for save papers save trees.
